This exhibition takes visitors on a journey dedicated to the many facets of Bagnoli's work and poetics, fifty years after the artist's passing. In addition to the biographical introduction, the exhibition itinerary features three sections: Harmony and Vibration, Form and Matter, Form and Fire, which outline together the main stages of Bagnoli's work.

255 artists submitted their entries to participate to Open Studio, representing 23 different countries from all over the world, not just Italy: USA, China, Hungary, Latvia, France, Croatia, Belarus, Portugal, Romania, Spain, Switzerland, Chile, Brazil, Mexico, Colombia, New Zealand, the Netherlands, Poland, Puerto Rico, Russia, Germany, Ukraine and Egypt.

Out of all these candidates, only 56 of them were selected to compete for the final prize. Open Studio was created with the intention of capturing a snapshot of contemporary Italian and international ceramics, showcasing artists from different backgrounds and generations, active on the national and international scene. Eugenio Taccini (Montelupo Fiorentino, 1943–2025) was one of the most renowned artisan-artists in Montelupo Fiorentino and in Tuscany, as well as an icon and ambassador of Florentine and Tuscan art on the national and international scene. The exhibition. hosted in the exhibition rooms of Montelupo's Ceramics Museum, traces Taccini's artistic evolution through a selection of works that shows the variety of his research and his ongoing dialogue with the ceramic tradition of the area. The exhibition itinerary creates a chrono-thematic narrative that interweaves his production with the history of Montelupo and with the artistic and artisan heritage of the Florentine and metropolitan area.


